We carry out regular tracking to assess the impact of interventions and support on children's self-esteem, confidence and attainment. This information is used to monitor and evaluate the impact of PPG and school funding. If your child takes part in a targeted intervention programme we measure how they are doing at the start of the programme and at the end so we can see the difference.

We report children's progress to all parents and carers at the termly 'Parents Evenings'. Your daily support with home learning activities such as reading and mental maths (see Animal Awards) is so important and makes a big difference to your child's learning.
