STAFFING UPDATES

Leadership Team- We have Mrs Vanessa Nice joining us as Head of School in June. She will support the day to day running of the school under the direction of Mrs Morris. Mrs Morris will continue to be headteacher and lead the school as she has previously but Mrs Nice will now support with this. We are not looking to make significant changes to our school and want to reassure you all that there will be no disruption just more stability. For the rest of the summer term Mr Haughey will continue as Deputy Headeacher and Mr Thomas will still be our Assistant Headteacher.

COMMUNICATION

We have had some concerns raised about incorrect information sharing and the use of parent WhatsApp groups. We pride ourselves on effective communication with families and clarity on information shared from school. All communication and information sharing has to













come directly through the leadership team of the school- Mrs Morris Headteacher or Mr Haughey Deputy headteacher. If you are unsure of any whole school arrangements or have any general queries, it is always best to bring these to the attention of school rather than using social media / WhatsApp to communicate. Whilst I appreciate these are a useful means of communication and great for reminders and information sharing between parents, they can often cause added confusion and this is not what any of us want - so always contact the school office directly if you are unsure or require clarification. Please avoid directly emailing members of staff for whole school messages, you should contact the school office who will always check information with leaders. Class email/DoJo accounts should only be used in rare circumstances where you need to directly contact the class teacher. This should not be done outside of their working hours and should be reasonable. We will be starting the Parent Class Rep Group again in June so look forward to working with families to further improve communication.
