Zero Tolerance

We do not tolerate any swearing, abusive or confrontational behaviour on the school premises or directed towards our staff. We understand that on occasions you may be upset or have concerns regarding your children that you would like addressing. We must ask that this is communicated in a reasonable and respectful manner. Our staff have the right to be spoken to in a polite and courteous manner, the same way in which they speak to you. The children and families who come to our school are greeted in a friendly and calm manner and we do not expect them to be subjected to listening to raised voices or confrontational behaviour. Poor conduct will not be

tolerated and may result in a ban from the school premises. This is the same for any written correspondence or telephone contact. Thank you for supporting us in this.

Uniform

We understand that this is a difficult time of year when your children have grown out of their uniform, particularly school shoes, and there may be a reluctance to purchase new items prior to the summer holidays. However, it is non-negotiable that children in school present in full school uniform every day. If you are struggling financially, we can support you by drawing money out of our school account, we do this in extreme circumstances when families are hit with financial hardship and as such, they cannot meet the basic needs of their child. If you feel you may need this level of support, please let us know. Please note that children who are not in correct uniform will not be chosen to represent Eastway in certain events, such as assemblies, educational visits etc, they also do not like to stand out or feel different from their friends and this can cause them anxieties. Please let us help you, to help your child.
