Thursday, 14 <sup>th</sup> October	In school making memory boards	School uniform	Usual lunch arrangements	3:15pm
Friday, 15 <sup>th</sup> October	Watersports at the Albert Dock	Warm, comfortable clothing that won't hold too much water (no jeans) and you don't mind getting wet and dirty. Leggings and tracksuits would be best. Old trainers that can get wet. A waterproof coat.	A bag with a change of warm clothes, dry shoes and a towel.  Packed lunch and an extra snack (this will be provided for children on free school meals).	Approx 4.00pm - 4:15pm

Please be aware that pick up times are estimates. We will send you a text message at the time if we are likely to be much earlier or later.

If you would like to change your child's usual pick up arrangements, such as allowing them to walk home alone or if they usually walk home alone but you would like to pick them up, please notify the school office on 0151 677 1235. If we don't hear from you, we will keep to their usual arrangement.
