Relationship and Sex Education

Dear Parents and Carers,

I'm aware that Mrs Morris wrote to you in July last year to consult with you regarding Eastway's response to the Department for Education's updated guidance regarding Personal, Social, Health and Economic (PSHE) education and Relationships and Sex Education (RSE).

Following a review of our curriculum to refine content to meet the needs of children at Eastway, we have recently reviewed what will be taught in PSHE and RSE and wanted to share more detail of this with you. Our PSHE and RSE curriculum aims to support your child's development to:

- Embrace their own individuality and sense of self with confidence
- Embrace the individuality of others and challenge stereotypes
- Know about their bodies and how they change as they get older
- What healthy relationships look like and how to develop these, focusing on relationships with family and friends
- How to keep safe, including first aid, internet safety and looking after their mental well-being
- What bullying is and what to do if they think they or someone else is being bullied
- How to be positive citizen of Moreton, UK and the world
- Develop their aspirations for what they would like to do when they are older and how to manage their money

All of the sessions will be age-appropriate and meet the needs of all pupils in the class.
