Free School Meals

CHANGE IN TERM DATES 2019/20

There has been a recent change to the May Bank Holiday 2020. This is to coincide with the 75th Anniversary of VE Day, the Bank Holiday will be on Friday 8th May 2020, meaning that school will be closed on this date. To make each half term equal, we have spread the INSET days across the school year. School will be closed for pupils on INSET days (staff development days).
