Due to some training needs for our staff and requirements of the school, we are having to move our INSET Days from Monday 21st July and Tuesday 22nd July to Friday 25th October and Monday 4th November. The total cost is £5.00 per child, per club. We are running Swimming after school lessons next week Reception to Y6 and you can book these on ParentPay. Apologies for the delay in launching our Homework Club, due to staff shortages this half term, we will start these after the October half term break.

# Attendance & Punctuality

It is important that children attend school regularly in order to receive the education they deserve. When children miss school, they miss core learning and find it difficult to catch up.

It is vital that we receive a reason for absence if your child is absent from school. In order to update the codes on our registers appropriately, we must have this information. We will place an O code which indicates an absence has not been authorised if we do not have a reason for absence. We will use the I code for any absence where a child is unwell. If you call the school office and leave a message, we may call you back during the day for an update. This is to check in with you and ask how your child is getting on.

It is also important that medical appointments are made outside of the school day where possible. We may request evidence of this in the form of a letter or text message. We have had a few requests from families recently who have wanted to collect all of their children to attend a medical appointment for one child. If appointments are made during the school day, it is important that only the child who has the appointment attends. If you require wraparound care whilst you and your child attend the appointment, we would encourage you to use our Swashbuckler's Club (SAS club).

### Monster Ball

On Thursday 24<sup>th</sup> October, we will be having a disco in school. Our Eastway Explorers, Nursery and Lunar Base children are welcome to come to school in Halloween costumes on Thursday 24<sup>th</sup> October for a spooky themed day of fun. Reception, Apollo, Years 1 and 2 children will get changed in school (if they wish) and go straight to their disco at 3.00pm and will need to be collected at 4.15pm from their normal exits. Please send your child's disco clothes/costume into school in the morning (in a named bag). If you do not want your child to attend, they can be collected at 3.15pm as usual.

Years 3, 4, 5, 6, Discovery & Enterprise Base children will go home as usual at 3.15pm, then return for their disco at 4.30pm, dressed to impress! Their entrance and collection will be from the Main



School Entrance. Please note that children will not be permitted to walk home alone after the disco. They must be collected by an adult at 5.30pm and must not bring mobile phones. We will also have a low sensory, inclusive disco for our SEN pupils in the afternoon. The children who leave school on transport will be collected at the normal time at the end of the day but still be able to attend their disco during the school day. If your child has additional needs and would still like to attend with their friends in the allocated time, they are more than welcome to.

Children attending Swashbucklers After School Club will be taken around to the disco, should they wish to attend. Tickets will be £2 each (cash payment please) and this will include spooky crafts, face paint, tattoo and a goody bag.

### Family Hub

Our Eastway Family Hub has lots of exciting training opportunities for families coming up, dates will be shared shortly so keep your eyes peeled! We now have a regular Stay & Play session every Friday morning 10am-11am; this is for children aged 0-5 Years. Jen from the ADHD Foundation will run the group and will have available 3x 1:1 sessions afterwards where you can get any SEN advice. These are bookable via Eastway Family Hub. Everyone is welcome so please do come along! We also have regular drop-in sessions from Citizens Advice Bureau and the Department of Working Pensions. These services are there for you to get free confidential advice and are available to everyone in the community.

Our Eastway Pantry is fully stocked thanks to NEO community. Pantry opening times are 8:30-2:30pm each day. As the Autumn weather has well and truly hit us, it's time to get the winter coats back out. The Family Hub has winter coats in stock as well as uniform, if you wish to take a look.

### **Starting Primary School 2025**

For children due to start full time school, Reception Class, in September 2025 we have an open day on Wednesday 16th October at 10am-11am to welcome new families, so if you know anyone who is looking for a school place for their child, please spread the word!
