If the decision is taken that the school has to close for the safety of its pupils and staff, the following procedure will be followed:

If it is before school has started in the morning:

- A message will be put on the website, Facebook and Twitter
- A text message alert will be sent to all parents/carers
- Announcements will be made on local radio stations

If it is during the school day while pupils are in school:

- A message will be put on the website
- A text message alert will be sent to all parents/carers

In the event that pupils are not able to be collected from school before the normal end of the school day, the school will ensure that they are looked after until they can be collected at 3.15pm. After school clubs will be cancelled. There may be different arrangements but in to lace to ensure the safety of all during adverse weather, such as the playgrounds being closed, different access points and pick up/ drop off arranges and we will make use of our social media, website and text message service to keep you updated.
