We are seeking further advice on how to manage this unacceptable behaviour and will continue to take action against parents displaying such negative behaviour. Our staff come to work to care and education the children and it is important for all members of our staff to be treated with courtesy and respect. In line with the rest of the local authority and to ensure this is fully observed, we have a Dignity at Work and Zero Tolerance Policy. Aggressive or violent behaviour towards our staff or any member of the public within our school premises will not be tolerated under any circumstances. Anyone giving verbal abuse to members of staff, either in person or over the telephone, will be sent a letter from the Headteacher advising that this behaviour will not be tolerated. Any future violation of this policy will result in further action being taken. We feel sure that you will understand that proper behaviour is absolutely necessary for our staff and children and that non-observance will not be tolerated. We work hard to create a calm, orderly and positive environment for the children of Eastway and hope that you will work with us to ensure that this continues and that the school rules and decisions made by the leadership of the school are adhered to and respected.
