Check Consent Form. These were sent home last week to those families that aren't already in receipt of Free School Meals. We are able to carry out a check on your behalf even if you child is only in Early Years or KS1, then as soon as your child enters Year 3 you won't need to worry about paying for lunches (unless circumstances change). Look at the benefits:

- A free school meal for your child, which is good for their health and could help with their
- Savings for you, worth over £350 per year

Collecting Pupils from School

To ensure the safety and welfare of the pupils at Eastway, we have very clear procedures for letting the children out at the end of the school day. Children from age 2 to Year 4 must be collected by an adult and someone who is known to the school and the child. We have a list of people who are able to collect in each class to ensure that our pupils are sent home in the care of a trusted adult and in agreement with parents and carers. If you need to update this list, please speak to your child's class teacher. Please note that we are unable to send children home with older siblings, unless this has been pre-arranged and agreed with the headteacher. I hope that you understand that this is to ensure the safety of all of our pupils and will support us with this. Year 5 and 6 children may walk home from school but we must be informed, please speak to your child's class teacher.

Conduct in School

I was saddened to hear that there were a number of parents who were using offensive and aggressive language towards staff on our recent Sports Day. I also noted that many were not responding to polite requests to follow direction from staff to keep our children safe and ensure that the day ran smoothly. We want to work with parents and carers and involve you in our whole school events but I must make it clear that if poor conduct continues to be an issue, parents/ carers will no longer be invited in to school or be able to volunteer on school trips. I hope that this will no longer be a concern in the future and that a small minority will not ruin it for the rest of our school community.
