Open Evening

On Wednesday 6th March 3:30-5:45pm we will be having an Open Evening for families from Reception to Year 6. There will be an opportunity for you to see your child's class, their work and speak with teachers. If you need a more private 5/10 minute chat please speak to class teacher or book an appointment. We will also have our leadership team, SENCO and Pastoral Support available in our school hall if you want to speak with anyone. Eastway Explorers and Nursery will have a Stay and Play Session in the coming weeks to give parents and carers the opportunity to speak to your child's class teacher. Our children who access Resource Base Provision (Apollo, Discovery & Enterprise) will not have an Open Evening in their base class but if they access learning in their mainstream class, you are welcome to attend to speak with the year group class teacher.

MidYear Reports

The reports for Year 1- 6 will be given out to families who attend tomorrow's Open Evening. For those who cannot make it, we will send the reports home after school on Thursday and copies to all those with parental responsibility. Please note that the reports are only for children who sit tests in school and relate to the progress that they make, the December tests test what the children know at this time of year after being taught new content in their new year group. Often these tests are not comparable so your child may be 'off track' at this time but able to make good progress throughout the rest of the year. Class teachers will let you know how you can best support at home. If your child's attendance and punctuality is a concern, this will also be raised in the report. We need to make sure that all children are in school every day that they can to get the best from their learning and social opportunities.

Family Hub@Eastway



We are so proud to tell you that we are opening a Family Hub in the Summer Term. This will mean extended services being available in our Family Centre for all families and our wider community. What are Family Hubs?

Family Hubs are spaces where families can easily access a wide range of nonjudgemental support to help them live well in Wirral. They bring together maternity services, health visitors, infant feeding support, parenting support and activities for children aged 0 to 5.

Wirral's Family Hubs make services easier to navigate and more joined-up, ensuring families receive the right service at the right time.



Bringing Learning to Life

Family Hubs provide:

a 'single front door model' style of support to build connections and strengthen relationships a service for families with children aged 0 to 19 (up to age 25 with SEND) provide information and support to adults in those families, for example, women's health issues, advice

on lifelong learning and employment

a space for parents and carers to meet each other and attend group sessions

We will let you know the launch day in the coming weeks and look forward to you joining us to celebrate.

NEW Early Years Class!!

Eastway Navigators will open after the Easter holidays. This new room will be for our 'tweenies' those who are in-between the 2 Year Old Eastway Explorers Room and Nursery Class. The room will help us increase the amount of children we take in school and enable a smoother transition for our youngest children. We cannot to see them settle in their amazing new room. The expansion of Early Years and the opening of

the Family Hub will mean that our base classes will also be moving. Apollo will use Discovery room and Discovery will move to Enterprise. Enterprise will then set up camp in our Therapeutic Classroom. We will work in the coming weeks to prepare our children for this change.

We will also be providing paid for childcare sessions on these dates which can be booked on ParentPay. Further information and booking form will be sent next week.
