Practical Matters

Independence

One of our main aims in SCD2 is to promote independence. Children will be given classroom responsibilities and be expected to take care of their own things in class. Please ensure that all uniform is well labelled.

Toys & things from home

We do not allow children to bring in items from home, we do not have anywhere to store them in the classroom and wouldn't like anything to get damaged or lost.

Milk & Fruit

The children are encouraged to drink water regularly throughout the day and children are encouraged to bring in water bottles, taking them regularly to wash. We provide fruit and milk at playtime. Please do not send snacks in with your child.

Physical Education

We will be having PE with our mainstream classes in an afternoon; your child will need black pumps. P.E. kits are provided by school.

Homework

The purpose of homework in SCD2 is to enable parents to be involved in working with the school to help their child. It helps to consolidate and reinforce skills and understanding developed at school, and supports the attitude that learning is not confined to the classroom, but that it is an open ended and life-long activity. Please help by being actively involved in your child's homework, encouraging your child and praising them when they have completed their homework and showing them that their work is valued. Please do not stress too much if sometimes your child is unwilling to complete any homework or home learning. We fully understand that sometimes after a full day at school additional work at home alters their routine. However much you try is a step in the right direction.

Homework in SCD 2 will include:

Reading

Reading is a really important part of the work that we do in SCD2, as the more we read, the better writers we become. Please help your child by reading with them every day. This can be Bug Club online reading or sharing a story book together. Please encourage reading strategies.

These strategies include:

- Identifying the title, front cover, author, 'blurb', page numbers
- Discussing the story/information and illustrations
- Using their phonics i.e. blending the sounds together
- Using the illustrations
- Knowledge of word cards
- Leaving the unfamiliar word and reading on.

Phonics

The children in SCD2 are at different stages in their phonetical knowledge so homework will be different. For some children they will be accessing the Teach Your Monster to Read app, which can be downloaded to iPads and tablets at home and at school.

Topic

Homework will link to our topic each half term.

We will have the chance to share what we have learnt in class together.
