

Dear Parents and Carers,

Reception Class to Year 6 Sports Day will held on Friday 23rd May 2025. Children will need to come to school that day wearing trainers, a T-Shirt in their team colour and shorts. Children MUST NOT wear football kits.

The children will be competing in their colour team: Yellow, Red, Green and Blue. A separate letter is being sent home to inform you of your child's colour team on Monday.

The children will compete in team sports during the morning session and gain points for their teams and in the afternoon there will be races, followed by a whole school presentation.

We would like to invite families to join us for a picnic lunch from 12 noon. Our fabulous kitchen team will be preparing picnic lunches for the children (free of charge for all free school meal pupils and all pupils in Reception and Years 1 and 2) and £2.00 per lunch for all other pupils (payable in the usual way via Parentpay). If you are going to provide a lunch for your child, please inform your child's class teacher.

You are invited to bring your own picnic lunch so that you will be able to sit with your children and enjoy a family picnic on the Key Stage One Playground. Please enter the school via the Main Entrance and you will collect them from their classroom. Children without family members attending will have their picnic with school staff so they will not be left out.

The bell will ring at 12.45pm for children to line up and return to their class for registration. Parents will move to the school field ready for the races and the children will come out class by class and sit on the opposite side of the track. Please can I ask that parents and carers do not have contact with the children during the afternoon session. There are a lot of races to get through and we need the afternoon to run smoothly.

At the end of the day, class teachers will return all children to their classes and they can be collected from there. Please do not take children directly from the field, we have a duty to ensure that all children are safe and accounted for and appreciate your cooperation with this.

We are happy for photographs of children to be taken at this event but I would urge parents and carers not, under any circumstances, to share images of other children on social media.

We hope it will be a fun day and that you will enjoy it too.
