This half term year six are learning about the history of New Brighton. To help the children visualise where the different attractions were, Y6 will be visiting New Brighton on:

We will be travelling to and from New Brighton by train and will return to school before the end of the school day. The children will have their lunch in New Brighton. Please provide your child with a packed lunch in a carrier bag, clearly labelled with their name. If your child is entitled to a free school meal, a packed lunch will be provided by school.

As this will be your child's final Eastway trip, we want to make it special for them. For this reason, the children will have a fun morning in New Brighton and then they will find the locations of historical landmarks in New Brighton during the afternoon.

The money the children raised in their enterprise project will go towards giving all children a game of bowling and a game of Laser Quest. As a farewell gift from Eastway, we will fund the remaining cost of this and the travel. There is no charge to families for this trip, though you may want to send your child with money to buy an ice-cream on the day (£3 maximum).

As we will be outside for the majority of this trip, please ensure that your child is prepared for the weather: sun hats, plenty of water and sun cream if it's sunny and water proof clothing if it's rainy.
