Dear Parents and Carers,

Within this envelope is your child's End of Year Report. It follows the format of the Mid-Year Report, so that it is easy to see the progress that your child has made and if they have achieved their own personal targets. Your child is delivered an age specific curriculum and they are reported as meeting these National age related expectations by the end of that year, still working towards meeting them or having exceeded them, working at greater depth. Even if your child has not achieved the end of year expectations, they will still have made progress this year and your child's class teacher will comment on the progress that they have made in their report. Some children with additional needs may be working on P Scales, so their progress and attainment will be reported on using the number and code system. Within the envelope you will also have a copy of the staffing list for 2020/21, the Term Dates for next year, a Data Collection update form and Home School Agreement.

The children have reflected on their learning during the year and commented, at an age appropriate level, on what they have learnt and enjoyed during the year and what they would like to focus on next year; this is included with this report.

Please note that the attendance figures provided on your child's report are taken from the recorded data up until 18th June 2021 and the percentage does not include COVID related absence.

I have read and commented on your child's report this year and I am incredibly proud of every single one; the progress that they have made and the delightful comments that their class teachers, who clearly know them so well, have written about them. I hope that you enjoy sharing them with your child and looking at their targets for next year. It has been another difficult year for our school and particularly our children. We are so proud of them and the resilience that they have shown. Engagement in Remote Learning during the Spring Term lockdown was outstanding and we genuinely thank our families wholeheartedly with your support in ensuring that your children were accessing daily learning at home, it really made the difference. Eastway has been part of a National Project for tracking pupil outcomes over this last two years so that we can see the impact of school closures on progress and attainment. We have been so pleased that although some children may have dipped slightly or not made as much progress in specific areas, our team have done an amazing job to ensure that every child is back on track and achieving well.

Thank you so much for your continued support and a huge thanks to all the team at Eastway for ensuring that your child's year has been a success, despite the ongoing disruption due to the pandemic. I am so proud of my staff and the hard work and commitment they have given to help children develop a love of learning, continue to make good progress and enjoy school.
