## **Behaviour Regulation**

Over the last two years we have been working with the whole school community to review our Behaviour Policy, a copy is on our school website <a href="https://eastway.eschools.co.uk/website/policies\_and\_procedures/50355">https://eastway.eschools.co.uk/website/policies\_and\_procedures/50355</a>

At Eastway we explicitly teach our children to manage their own emotions and see behaviour as a way of communicating. After consultation with staff, children and families we are going to keep the Good to Be Green system. All children will display Green behaviours in school and this is our expectation. For children who need reminding, they may be given some yellow thinking time to allow them to correct their behaviour. For persistent poor behaviour or extreme behaviours your child may be issued with a red card, these incidents are very rare and you will be informed if this happens and if it continues we may invite you in to school to discuss how we can support your child. For those children who go over and above and display consistent excellent behaviour, they will receive a Gold Headteacher commendation. They will be invited to attend special Headteacher event in school to celebrate this - our children love this and always strive to be Going for Gold.

All children have clear expectations at Eastway. They follow our Code of Conduct:
