Uniform


A reminder that all children must wear full uniform for school. Trainers and sandals are not part of our school uniform at Eastway. We have high standards of presentation at Eastway and encourage our children to have pride in their appearance and represent our school's smart culture. We are happy to support any family that may find it difficult and also have our uniform store in the Family Centre where you can pick up anything you need. We have just received a very kind donation from Tesco of some brand new red gingham summer dresses, so pop in! Remember that children do not wear any jewellery to school or make up and no toys, stationery or items from home should be brought in.

School Debts

We are completely understanding that some of our families may be struggling at this time and the cost of living crisis is having an impact on many. However, when money is owed to school it directly impacts our school budget. We do not have any additional funds as school budgets have also been cut and we have too been impacted by significant rises in costs. When money is not cleared for debts it prevents us from spending on our own services and ability to provide things needed for our children. If you owe money to school, the team will contact you to help you clear it as soon as possible. If you need help, please speak to us.

Easter Holiday Club

We have received the funding from the DfE to run our holiday provision! School will be open 10-2 on Monday 8th April to Thursday 11th April for FREE in school sessions only for children in Reception to Year 6.
