Toast Club - Starting Monday 29th January

Just a reminder - this will be a drop in session from 8.15am every morning, there is no need to book. Access will be from the gate on Oundle Road and through the Feastway Canteen door. Eastway staff will meet you at the door and you will need to sign your child in and pay on the day- 50p day for the first child - if you have more than one child, the cost will be10p each for the extra children. If you would like to pay in advance, please see the staff in toast club. If you are struggling financially please speak to us as we may be able to support you in making use of this service and ensuring that your children receive breakfast before school. Children will be able to have their breakfast with their friends, catch up on homework and play games before being taken down to their classrooms.

Playtime snacks

As the children will no longer receive toast at morning break time they will now be able to bring in a piece of fruit for morning break in Key Stage Two and if they have milk, they will still receive this during morning playtime. Please do not send any unhealthy snacks in for your children as these will be confiscated and your child will go without a snack.

Uniform

We had sent a letter home a couple of weeks ago concerning wearing the correct School Uniform, this still is an issue for some, so would like to remind all parents that this is an important part of school life, it portrays the school's ethos and shared values, and when signing the **Home School Agreement** when your child first started at Eastway Primary, you have agreed to make sure your child wears the correct Uniform and P.E kit at all times.

Bumped Head Bands

Should your children have a bumped head incident during their school day they will now come home wearing a red wrist band so that you are aware there has been an incident. There should also be information shared with you regarding the first aid that was administered and signs to look out for follow any head injury.

Staff Car Park

Please can we remind parents not to use the car park on Oundle Road for the dropping off and collection of children - This is a staff & visitor car park only. We have children using that car park with before and after school club staff and there is a risk to their safety if we allow others to have access to this area.
