## **KS1 Christmas Performance**

Dear Parents/Carers,

Your children are really excited about the Christmas Performance and have been asking us what costumes they need. Below we have highlighted your child's role and detailed some costume suggestions to help:

Narrator: school uniform with red, gold or silver tinsel

Choir: school uniform with red, gold or silver tinsel

Conductor: school trousers, white shirt with a bow tie and waist coat if possible

Angel: white t-shirt and shorts/leggings or a white dress with silver tinsel you may like to add a halo or

wings

Mary: suitable traditional outfit (eg pale blue dress with headdress)

Joseph: suitable traditional outfit

Shepherds: suitable traditional outfit (an easy option would be a pillow case with a hole cut out for the head and arms with a belt and tea towel for the head)

Star: a suitable star outfit

Sheep: white trousers and top or sheep costume

Kings: suitable traditional outfit (plain t shirt and trousers with regal capes and crowns)

Camels: brown trousers and brown top or camel costume

Inn Keeper: plain t shirt, plain trousers and plain apron

Towns people: suitable outfit (an easy option would be a pillow case with a hole cut out for the head and arms with a belt and tea towel for the head) or plain t shirt, plain trousers and plain apron

Donkey: grey t shirt and trousers and tail or donkey costume

Barn animals: you may choose what animal to dress as that you would find on a farm for example, cow, pig, horse, sheep, chicken, donkey etc

Please could you send your child's costume in to school in a named carrier bag by Monday 10th December at the latest.

We do have a small number of costumes in school so if you are struggling please come and see your child's class teacher.
