Curriculum Focus- Parent Feedback

- $\checkmark$  All parents had accessed the school website to look at the revised curriculum

- ✓ Ask about Like Skills, EM explained that we have those skill taught throughout the year in each class but parents would like more information about this.
- ✓ Early Years Stay & Plays are great to see how the children learn
- Outdoor stuff is good, like forest schools and Year 6 residential but would like more of that
- ✓ Reading Workshop good to show how to do the phonics and help reading at home
- ✓ Twitter good for seeing what children are learning
