

# **Good To Be Green Behaviour System**

# **Information Leaflet For Parents/Carers**



## **Eastway Primary School**

At Eastway we expect all children to follow our agreed Code of Conduct. To help children meet this expectation and to reward those children who consistently behave well we have introduced a **Good to be Green** behaviour system.

In this system there are three colour zones Green, Yellow and Red

### **Green Zone**

All children begin every new week and every new day in **Green Zone** - which is where they want to stay!

To stay in **Green Zone** children must follow the Eastway Code of Conduct at all times

- Be Nice
- Learn Well
- Never Give Up

#### **Green Zone** rewards are:

- A weekly **Good 2 be Green** sticker and extra 'super play' on a Friday afternoon.
- A half termly Good 2 be Green badge and/or certificate
- A termly Good 2 be Green super treat.
- An end of year **Good 2 be Green** super celebration

## **Yellow Zone**

Yellow Zone is a WARNING ..... 'think hard about your behaviour'.

Before children are moved to **Yellow Zone** they are placed on the 'thinking cloud' or 'thinking frog' to **think about their behaviour** and are given the chance to return to **Green Zone** behaviour.

### Yellow Zone consequences are:

- Children do not earn that week's **Good 2 be Green** sticker and 'super play'.
- Children do not earn the half termly Good 2 be Green badge and/or certificate

### **Red Zone**

Children are moved to **Red Zone** for any serious incident or for persistently breaking the agreed Eastway Code of Conduct.

The names of any child who has to be moved to **Red Zone** are recorded on a weekly class behaviour sheet.

#### **Red Zone** consequences are:

- Children do not earn that week's Good 2 be Green sticker and 'super play' or the half termly Good 2 be Green badge and/or certificate.
- Children attend a meeting with a senior member of staff to explain their **Red Zone** behaviour.
- Behaviour is logged and monitored in the **Red Zone** book.
- Parents/carers are informed.

# REMEMBER all super Greeners earn super treats!

All children who stay consistently in **Green Zone** earn an extra half termly and termly reward and an end of year **Good 2 be Green** super celebration.
