Monday	Bushcraft, shelter building and campfire	Eastway	Wellies and a waterproof coat. Old, comfortable clothes that can get dirty such as tracksuits and leggings. No flammable materials such as shell suit material.	3:15pm

Thursday	Delamere Forest and Go Ape!	Delamere Forest	A waterproof coat. Old, comfortable clothes that can get dirty such as tracksuits and leggings. Comfortable trainers for our walk	6:00pm Children <u>must be collected from school by an adult</u> as it is later
Friday	Watersports	Liverpool	A waterproof coat. Old, comfortable clothes that can get dirty or wet such as tracksuits and leggings. Comfortable trainers that you don't mind getting wet. No jeans as these will hold too much water.	3:15pm
